His unique role is allowing him to use develop his business admin and organisational skills, whilst putting into practice his youth work experience to support young people in the North East to gain experience, confidence and work placements. When asked to sum up his first month as an apprentice at FIRST, he said "It's been an opportunity to grow my skill base in areas such as administration and enterprise, that before were lacking in comparison to my practical skills as a joiner and youth worker. FIRST has made my vision of one day becoming self-employed more attainable!"

In his first month Jackson has delivered enterprise

workshops to over 30 young people and has spoken at numerous youth events to encourage students and graduates to take on work placements. So far, he's has managed to match 7 young people to placements at FIRST and has built up a relationship with an additional 70 young people that he is working with to ensure their needs are met and that they are matched with roles and projects to allow them to develop the skills they need. Matt, one of the young people Jackson has matched to a work placement, said "Joining FIRST and working with Jackson has helped provide excellent opportunity for me due to learning new skills for the workplace but also the abilities to gain new knowledge and contacts, not only this but it's a very friendly environment which helps encourage your personal growth."
